

Squash Wellington (SW) Masters Coach 2021



We are seeking to recruit a SW Masters Coach to lead the development of the SW Masters Squad for 2021. The tenure for this role is for a period up until 30th October 2021.

We will be running an EOI (Expression of Interest) process to ensure a fair and transparent process is applied across Squash Wellington.

If you are interested in expressing an interest in this opportunity, please familiarise yourself with the 'Expectation of the Role' and the 'Application Process'.

Expectations of the Coach:

- Deliver agreed training sessions (likely to be between 4-6) leading up to the National event.
- Adhere to the Squash Wellington Code of Conduct

Note: The sessions are less likely to focus on technique (given most masters have most likely had technical coaching at some stage in their playing career) and more on training/working as a team.

During the event

- Attendance at the NZ Inter-District Masters teams event in Wellington on the 18-19th October and provide on court coaching for all players.
- Provide on court coaching at a level appropriate for each player.
- If two or more players are on court at one time the coach must communicate with the team manager to organise support.

Post event

- Provide a full written report to the Board within 10 working days of event completion (i.e. NZ Inter-District Masters teams). Template will be provided.

Person Specifications:

- Evidence of delivering successful squash programmes.
- Ability to build and maintain successful working relationships
- Well-developed inter-personal skills
- High level of playing knowledge and ability
- Passionate about ensuring the success of Masters Squash in Wellington

Application Process:

- Outline the experience you will bring to the role
- Covering letter
- Provide indicative high level training plan with an estimated quote
- Prepared to provide evidence if required

Selection panel will be made up of the SW Masters Convenor, SW District Manager and SW Masters Working Group members.
